To attend NYLT, you must:

- Be 13, but not yet 18.
- Be at least First Class.
- Hold a Troop Leadership Position or be eligible for a Troop Leadership Position.
- Have been on long-term camps with your Troop.
- Have mastered outdoor skills required for 1<sup>st</sup> Class.
- Be recommended and approved by your Scoutmaster.
- Pay a \$50 reservation fee with your application; total cost is \$200.

This exciting experience will be limited to 48 Scouts. The Council reserves the right to limit the number of Scouts from the same Troop in order to enable as many troops as possible to send Scouts. While NYLT will occur during the third week of summer camp, NYLT will be conducted separate from and will not be a part of the regular summer camp program.

Application forms will be available at the Scout Service Center in September.
